

SafeRide to Polling Stations



Volunteer Call Outs

Promise Partnership

The Student Mentoring Program pairs UNB Saint John student volunteers with youth from kindergarten to grade 5 at Hazen White-St. Francis School.

From September to April volunteers spend an hour a week at Hazen White-St. Francis. Mentors provide educational support through engaging in structured activities designed to assist in literacy learning.

Sessions run Monday to Thursday through fall and winter semesters. Mentoring provides the youth with a positive role model, as well as academic and social support. UNB Saint John volunteers gain hands-on experience and build meaningful connections. The High School Tutoring Program is a twice-weekly tutoring initiative offered to the youth from Crescent Valley and the Old North End in grades 9-12.

This intensive tutoring initiative based out of our Saint John campus is geared to ensure students are on track for a timely high school graduation and to encourage post-secondary options.
